## 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Classes

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**Study Skills / Accelerated Reader:** This course will begin with a focus on organizational and study skills to assist students as they transition into middle school. Throughout the semester, students will also use the Accelerated Reader program to develop their skills in reading fluency and comprehension.

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**Computer Applications:** Students will be introduced to many aspects of school and business computing.
